Five Tips for a Responsible Campfire Leave no Trace Principle #5

Know your local rules and regulations.

Is a campfire necessary? Is there another source for warmth, ambiance and light?

Only burn dead down wood that is smaller than your wrist.

Keep it in an established fire ring, don't create your own.

Stay attentive to your fire, never leave camp while a campfire is burning.
